

It's official: Shooting games are the norm these days. From Operation Wolf (1987), then on to Mechanized Attack (1988), Blood Bros, Buster Bros, and Mercs (1989), The Time Crisis Series (1995-2008), as well as the Big Buck Hunter Group (2000-2010), this is where the action is? You can add Target: Terror Gold (AKA TARG Terror by us wizards) to this list as well.

Created by Raw Thrills, TTG shows amazingly violent graphics, yet the artwork is seemingly lifelike. You are part of an elite task force embarking on 3 critical missions: The Airport, the Golden Gate Bridge, and a Nuclear Chemical Power Plant. The goal: Kill all enemies to move on to the next stage of the mission. (There are three stages in all, for a total of 9). If you complete all the missions (finishing all 3 stages in each), the gamer

unlocks a hidden 10th mission known as the Hijacking (more on this in a moment).

DON'T FORGET TO RELOAD! You only have ten busts in your gun, so aim off screen to keep your sidearm loaded - And DON'T SHOOT THE CIVILIANS! Any lost life of a hostage will cost one of yours.

Throughout the stages, you can shoot some Power-up items scattered around or in computer terminals or cameras. Shotguns, machine guns, or rifles can be reloaded just by aiming off screen. Grenade launchers, flamethrowers, and freeze guns can only be used once, so when they run out, you go back to a regular gun.

Finally, all headshots, killing streaks, secrets, damage, and killing percentage are added to your score. And if you reach the High Jacking, be careful! There's a certain part of the mission where there is no continuation. If you fail, you must start the High lacking from the beginning.








BATTLESTAR GALACTICA COLONIAL VIPER

We are making a rare detour away from vinyl this month to introduce you to **TENVOLT FOR THE HOLIDAYS**, a delightful compilation of Ottawa artists performing original and traditional holiday and wintery songs. This album was released last year, and the styles range from traditional country/ Americana to some classic rock 'n roll numbers.

On the more traditional side, THE KINGMAKERS bring us their rendition of the classic Jingle Bells, and the very Christmas sounding tunes Christmas Time is Coming performed by KJ THOMAS and Christmas Without You by SCARLETT HANNAH.

DRIVE-IN RADIO provide the classic prison holiday song and channel their inner Johnny Cash with Christmas in Folsom, while your favourite advice columnist SLO' TOM takes us on a lonely winter tour of Ottawa with the "down on his luck" lament



Bytown New Year's Eve.

Of course, some artists can't resist injecting a bit of humour into the proceedings. Smash! Bang! Boom! By TULIPS AND DEVILSHIPS is a holiday mystery that's easy to solve, JOHN ALLAIRE'S I Saw Elvis Dressed Like Santa turns up the rock and gets the King in on the fun, and RAY HARRIS somehow manages to fit Santa, the Baby Jesus, and a whole lot of booze into his The Last Christmas Song (check out the new video for this one, you can find it on Facebook on Ray's and Tenvolt's pages).

Plus there is much more I don't have space for!

All said, this is an album that you can play over the holidays and your family isn't likely to protest. It's a great option if you're like me and can't bear the thought of sitting through days of traditional carols, and you want to get into the holiday spirit without losing your mind. Plus, you can show off some of the great talent we have here in Ottawa to your fam who probably still think we live in a boring old government town!

AN INTERVIEW WITH

LESLEY MARSHALL

AKA LESLEY DEMON AKA LES666 OCCUPATION: FOUNDER, PRODUCER, INTERMEDIA ARTIST AT MAVN

It is always inspirational to see an artist work hard at their craft and parley those skills into a creative career that serves the community. Lesley's company MAVN (Marshall Audio-Visual Network, pronounced "maven" like raven) is one such success story. When she isn't providing creative, technical & strategic support for her wide range of clients she can't help but stay busy with some of her widely revered musical projects such as Bonnie Doon & Ginny. She's an award-winning filmmaker & her music videos have been featured on Vice, Exclaim!, Brooklyn Vegan, Aux, Rookie Mag etc. It pretty darn cool to see Lesley's Proudly femme-led business support/contract independent artists & technicians and produce work that reaches beyond the borders of the 613.

WHAT JOBS AND EXPERIENCES HAVE LED TO YOUR PRESENT POSITION(S)?

Oh a lot! I've kind of always had multiple jobs, volunteer commitments and projects. I worked as a gallery assistant and grocer in kw before moving to Ottawa for university. In school here, I supported myself working at the Bytowne Cinema, doing odd building jobs at a theatre and house in Renfrew and Arnprior and even did my time slinging coffee at Bridgehead. My love of music and organizing got me pretty involved in putting on shows and events at local venues and with being really interested in video and film I always had a camera going. That turned into music videos for artists and film festival projects which is the foundation of my A/V company, MAVN. After university I was already volunteering at SAW Video in exchange for free gear and editing time

so when a position opened up I was pretty excited to join their team. Learned a lot about grants, technical production and migrated through the office as the Operations Manager, then Workshop Coordinator then into Production and Communication on contract after deciding to leave to work fulltime at what is now Kelp MGMT then became a founding member of MEGAPHONO. My business picked up and I followed the change and when the time was right went fulltime freelance for MAVN doing a multitude of projects from A/V documentation, commercial video, festival films, photography, marketing, pr and consulting. Now I work with a couple team members, incorporated in 2019 and grow with contractors project to project, always got my eye on the next wave.

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL WORK DAY

ENTAIL FOR YOU?

A lot of communication - lol - I (try to) keep regular business hours to respect my personal / private life balance, so at a work desk by 9am, usually have a couple meetings about future projects scheduled through the day, work on post production for upcoming deadlines, social media, book gear and advance creative for upcoming productions doing general admin.

I subscribe to a lot of e-newsletters lol and


following my interests on social media and IRL connections.

Movies like Filibus were brought


about when Nickelodeon owners in the early incarnation of movie theatres sought to legitimize what society and the media condemned as places that glorified offerings of scandalous themes, populated by dangerous viewers. They thought



that convincing women to attend would garner a sign of cultural acceptance from their opposition, so filmmakers created dramas featuring "modern women."

An amazing feat that this plan was instigated, considering how difficult it has been for women characters in cinema for the decades to follow, right up to the present day. Our heroine was daring, strong willed, adventurous, bold, a leader who didn't take a back seat to men, and was on both sides of the law. In an age when women couldn't get divorced, inherit property, or get a newspaper subscription without their husband's authorization, she reflected hope for a new vision of women in fiction.

Signs pointed towards the trend continuing, but such product has been somewhat few and far between, with more steps in the right direction happening of late. With science-fiction heroes like Ripley and Princess Leia gaining legendary status in the late 1970s, or comic book characters like Captain Marvel and Harley Quinn finding grand box office success recently, women characters do find their place amongst big screen box



office success, but with shameful inconsistency. Previously, Filibus has only been available via a poorly subtitled, far from pristine version. It was recently remastered, restoring the remarkable quality as seen originally. Also, the Mont Alto Motion Picture Orchestra has created a striking new musical score gathered from historic photoplay music.

It's not often that a One Hundred and Four year old movie makes a return, a movie that's Seventeen years older than the Mayfair itself!

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
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
