Welcome to 2020, gamers! I would like to point out that the makers of Atari kept themselves busy throughout the '80's. Among their many accomplishments were Super Breakout (1980), Centipede (1981), and Millipede (1987).

That brings us to Crystal Castles, one of the few video games with an actual ending. The game features a character named Bentley Bear, whose surroundings are on the inside of a three-dimensional castle. Here Bentley (and the gamer) have one job: to gather all the gems within the corridor of each castle, all the while avoiding certain creatures such as boulders, skeletons, and ghosts. There are gem eaters, but you can kill them only when they're swallowing a gem, stay away from them, however, when they're on the move.

You'll also encounter trees on certain levels, but you can jump over them to temporarily disable these leafy nemesis and make them shrink.

If Bentley collects the last gem HI the castle, you'11 receive a 1000 point bonus. But if his enemies get the last L* gem first, the bonus is nullified. Collect all gems to move on to the next castle.

When Bentley dons the witches' hat on the 3rd level, he gains instant invincibility for about 10-15 seconds. He can even kill Berthilda the Witch with it if he catches her. There's also a pot of honey Bentley can eat for extra points, but watch out for THE SWARM OF BEES! If you take too much time on one level, the swarm will reappear.

Finally, you can warp from one level to another (1 to 5) by moving to a certain spot at the back of the castle, then press IUMP. This trick will work in different waves in specific locations.

MOTHER'S CHILDREN LEMON

Mammoth Cave Recording Co./Resurrection Records 2014 Produced and Engineered by Paul Granger Mastered by Daniel Husayn

LEMON is the second full-length from Ottawa's MOTHER'S CHILDREN, released in 2014. It sits alongside a strong set of singles and Eps released from 2009-2015, as well as their strong debut LP, That's Who, released in 2010.

The four piece includes KENNY JAMES (Vox, Guitars AKA DJ KJMAXX), DAVEY QUESNELLE (Bass, Guitars, Backing Vox), MICHAEL HURTS (Vox, Guitars), and TIM OSTLER (Drums, Percussion). You may recognize these names from loads of other Ottawa acts past and present, including MILLION DOLLAR MARXISTS, YEAR ZERO, PREGNANCY SCARES, STEVE ADAMYK BAND, URANIUM COMEBACK, and so many more. These guys are all over the Ottawa scene, and have been playing their part in our city's musical life for years.

This is pop music with an edge. Call it power pop, glam pop, pop punk, garage, or whatever,



the bottom line is that it is smart and full of hooks, with a double guitar attack that will keep any rocker happy. The easy comparison here is Canadian punk legends TEENAGE HEAD, but these guys take it a step beyond our heroes from Hamilton with their rhythm-driven punk fueled by Ostler's frantic drumming and an effective three man vocal sound that help fill the space between what is essentially complimentary double rhythm guitars. Early 70s rock influence is pretty evident here, from early STONES and KINKS to GRAND FUNK, and helps the band set themselves apart from other pop-punk contemporaries.

This album is full of ear-worms, making guitar solos seem unnecessary, and on the rare song when a guitar does take a moment in the spotlight the solos are simple affairs that accentuate the main theme of the song instead of the virtuosity of the players. A refreshing change from the self-indulgence many soloists fall prey to when given the chance to take centre stage.

For me, this is summer music, whether it's blasting from the car stereo on the highway or supplying your rock and roll fix on the deck at the cottage. A great listen on headphones, it is just as at home as background music while you take care of the mundane tasks of adulthood. It feels light and heavy at the same time, and no matter what you are doing this record will put a spring in your step and make the world seem like a great place to be, if only for a little while.

Some of the earlier stuff from these guys may be tough to find at this point, but I've seen both LEMON and the first LP around town on occasion in recent years. Definitely worth picking up LEMON, or any MOTHER'S CHILDREN you may stumble across. Happy digging!in your neighbourhood record peddler's bins.

AN INTERVIEW WITH

CAS HOUDE

AGE: 35 | PLACE OF BIRTH: IROQUOIS FALLS, ONTARIO OCCUPATION: BREWERS ASSISTANT ASHTON BREWING COMPANY (ABC)

A big part of the TARG community is the relationship with local craft breweries. Cas Houde from Ashton Brewery Company exemplifies that bond, as a life-long musician and now brewer of fine beverages! When she isn't putting in long hours at the brewery, working on her motorcycle, travelling, organizing events she is attending shows at Targ... actually, we don't know if she ever has any free time. Cas and ABC are helping push for more inclusivity in the craft brewery world, bringing together people of all backgrounds in the name of beer! In just a few years in the industry, Cas has worked extremely hard to make a name for herself; ABC, and fans of ABC, are lucky to have her!

WHAT JOBS AND EXPERIENCES HAVE LED TO YOUR PRESENT POSITION(S)?

Oh I've been with ABC for 5yrs, working as a cellar person/brewers assistant in day to day productions. I grew up on a small horse farm & have a background in Social Work/ Childcare, with a 10yr stint as a mediocre musician somewhere in between. Needless to say I'm a sucker for hard work! I met the Hodgins family (ABC owners) when I worked in Old Ottawa South and frequented Quinns Ale House for their Sunday open mics. I had zero knowledge of the craft beer industry but one day Quinn offered me a job at the brewery and I've been the weekend cellar person for ABC ever since! I learned everything "the Ashton way" and have been trained to brew on our old antique Peter Austin system.

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL WORK DAY ENTAIL FOR YOU?

I run the brew house solo on the weekends, so my work days are equally typical as they are unpredictable. My position is an independent one, while relying on a strong team work ethic so we can all get the job done & get a great product out on time! In one day ill do everything from managing the fermentation room, testing brews at all different stages, quality control, moving beers from tank to tank, filtering beers, cleaning, restocking our beer fridge in the Pub, social media/snapping photos, filling bottles/ growlers, handling some sales & marketing, doing some science-y things, did I mention cleaning (???) and my favorite job: filling/lifting kegs right before we send them out to our customers!

TELL US ABOUT A PROJECT OR ACCOMPLISHMENT THAT YOU CONSIDER TO BE SIGNIFICANT IN YOUR CAREER.

I think just being able to be IN this career is a big accomplishment for me. On one hand I had no background in this field and had to start from the bottom up. There is SO much to learn & that hands on education is truly endless. It's a big deal (to me) especially as the craft beer industry is a male dominated one, I really have

to hold space for myself. It's equally important that who I work for holds space for me too. And then on the other hand I had a bad (not work related) accident during my brew training, that just so happened to involve a high pressure/boiling water explosion. It caused a pretty high level of PTSD in me and coming back to work was really hard. I didn't really know if I could continue working at the brewery and it was scary to think I wasn't able to continue doing something I truly learned to love! Thankfully my boss is a wizard & my team is super awesome/patient, which helped me settle into a role thats outside of physically brewing the beer!

WHAT DO YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT WORKING IN YOUR INDUSTRY?

It's honestly really community oriented. I love seeing how breweries are willing to help each other out and how there are so many craft beer lovers/supporters in the world! Any time I get to do an event, I know it's going to be filled with great people- consumers and businesses/ employees alike! I love seeing how diversity & inclusiveness is progressing (slowly but surely), though I will always think more women and marginalized folks are needed with in the craft beer industry

HOW DO YOU BEST SEEK OUT OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEW PROJECTS?

For my brewery job, I'll usually bring any new trends or ideas to my boss and let him roll with it. I know that's not very exciting but we're kind of old school. As a self-titled "punk kid" I really dig the approach of 'let's focus on making a great product consistently, while becoming more accessible & keeping the business family operated'. I think it helps keep us focused by not constantly trying to keep up with crowd. Outside of brewery life I'm usually focused on my motorcycle, either adventuring or troubleshooting problems or working on an all womxn off-grid camping adventure that I organize (with a friend) every September! It's not hard to find new projects or inspiration when you have a motorcycle in your life!

HOW DO YOU KEEP UP WITH THE LATEST NEWS IN YOUR LINE OF WORK?

I spend a good amount of time scouring the Internet and reading beer blogs to catch up on trends, what beer lovers are looking for, what people like/dislike. Twitter is a pretty great place for anyone related to the beer industry- you can easily get lost in a rabbit hole thread of opinions over whether someone prefers a hazy IPA or Trad. IPA. Seeing as I run the social media for ABC, I really appreciate hearing what consumers have to say, not just about our beer but what's happening on the market.

WHAT WOULD YOU TELL SOMEONE ABOUT TO START A CAREER IN YOUR FIELD?

Tour brewery work spaces and ask yourself "Would I be cool with cleaning this?". Most of working in a brewery is keeping things clean- clean space. happy yeast, clean beer! No matter your position in the brew house, you have to be willing to clean, be organized, pay attention to detail, be a contortionist, adapt to cold/hot spaces, tap into your inner dreams of being a weight lifter etc etc. Research is the best thing anyone can do before jumping into a brewery career, whether that be physically going out to breweries, getting tours of different places or just talking to all the different types of people in this industry. I think everyone has this glorified idea that working in a brewery means you get to drink beer all day, but I'm here to tell you that there isn't an ounce of fun in drinking beers and having to lift 100+lbs a few dozen times!

FROM 2 THUMBS DOWN TO BECOMING A BENCHMARK IN THE HORROR GENRE. THE 40TH ANNIVERSARY OF FRIDAY THE 13TH

I have distinct childhood memories of tattered VHS boxes, and posters for the Friday the 13th movies, at the small town video store that my dad and I frequented. They were taboo, you weren't allowed to watch them, and parents likely wouldn't let you rent them. They were a fascinating lure, and the holy grail of the most important thing in the world that a geeky horror kid wanted to watch one day.

There was a simple enticing terror to the idea of teenagers getting



picked off by an unstoppable killer. The murderous weapon wielding monster aside, there was a realness to the original film, to the look of the actors, and the surroundings they were in. The main characters (victims) looked like they could be an older cousin, or a babysitter.

Even though (Spoiler!) there's no old timey goalie mask in the original (that shows up in Part III), Jason Voorhees (helped along by the "ki ki ki, ma ma ma" on the soundtrack) became arguably the iconic image of 1980s franchise horror films.

In 1980, with a budget of \$550,000, Friday the 13th made more than \$60 million worldwide. That doesn't even take into account VHS profits, during the peak of the video store boom era.

The reviews were hilariously negative.

Siskel and Ebert devoted an entire episode of their



episode of their show to tear the film apart. In the Chicago Tribune, Gene Siskel also called out the film as being "A disgusting, artless shocker" that was "only for sickies." Variety called it "low budget

in the worst sense—with no apparent talent or intelligence to offset its technical inadequacies", and the Baltimore Evening Sun thought it was "a shamelessly bad film".

Modern reviews are slightly more nostalgically favourable. The BBC praised its legacy as "a hugely influential film", and eFilmCritic gave it actual compliments, calling it "a benchmark in the horror genre", and said "I love this movie...it's a bloody good time".

The story has been expanded to novels, and Friday the 13th: The Series (which used the logo and title, but really had nothing to do with the films). Jason crossed paths with other horror legends in comics like Jason vs Leatherface, and Freddy vs Jason vs Ash.



There were video games as well, ranging from a Commodore 64 edition, to the more recent XBoxOne game. Plus, Jason appeared as a combatant in Mortal Kombat X. There's also the 1988 arcade game Splatterhouse, featuring a character wearing a suspiciously familiar hockey mask.

Crazily enough, you can walk into a Hot Topic and get a Friday the 13th shirt, a pair of socks, or boxer shorts.

Including Freddy vs Jason, and the 2009 remake, there are twelve Friday the 13th films. There have been numerous attempts for a new film over the past decade, hindered by endless behind-the-scenes battles over who owns both the title, and Jason Voorhees.

It's not every day that you get to watch the original Friday the 13th on a Friday the 13th, in celebration of its 40th anniversary. Catch it at the Mayfair on Friday March 13th!
