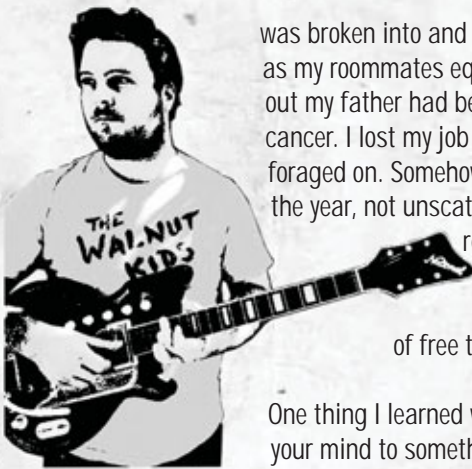

was broken into and I had my guitar as well as my roommates equipment stolen. I found out my father had been diagnosed with cancer. I lost my job over my own stupidity. I foraged on. Somehow I made it to the end of the year, not unscathed. Definitely would not recommend this project to anyone to undertake unless they have a lot of free time.

One thing I learned was that if you do put your mind to something and are passionate about it, you can make it happen! Go out and try something, challenge yourself! I wrote more songs than Kurt Cobain - take that history! Also I have a musical diary that I can go back to always and reminisce about the good, the bad and the ugly.

10 YEAR ANNIVERSARY PARTY

To celebrate the almost ten year anniversary of this monumental undertaking, I've organized a show at BLACK SQUIRREL BOOKS FRI JUNE 14, next door BFF's of House of TARG, and have invited some friends to help celebrate the milestone: SAD CANADIAN BOY (Ott Stargazing hip hop) + YARNS (Belgium Dream Pop) + DAY OF NIAGARA (Noise/Experimental) + MALE NURSE (me)!

Being a young ambitious songwriter and also having put out four E.P.'s and an album of material under the guise "Male Nurse" I agreed to the challenge, feeling confident that it would be a breeze... **TURNED OUT MORE LIKE A HURRICANE THAT TOOK OVER MY LIFE!**

Every day, regardless of work, band practice, social engagements or even sickness I would force myself to get my laptop out, set up microphones, guitars, ukuleles, keyboards, banjos, mandolins, drums etc. and bang out a song for that day. Try to write lyrics, sometimes fail. I allowed myself one cover song per week so that at least one day would be marginally easier than the others.

Brought my laptop on a couple tours and recorded from the road, even recorded Paul Collins (The Nerves, Paul Collins Beat) in his nyc loft while we were on tour together! Seemed like that was a pass! At one point my studio

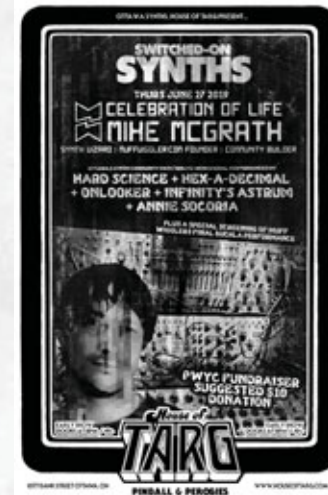

The most unusual fact about Mappy was that only 400 cabinets were made, but only 200 were released as the actual game itself. Bally Midway scooped up the rest of the cabinets and converted them into Junior Pac-Man conversions.

In Mappy, you portray a mouse patrolman trying to recover stolen goods in Goro's mansion. The graphics are stenciled beautifully, and the game music is based solely on ragtime. There are a total of 15 rounds in the game. While controlling Mappy, the player uses trampolines to jump from floor to floor, collecting all the items awhile dodging Goro himself (Boss The Big Bit) and his notorious henchmen Meowsky (Naughty Folks). Don't run into these villains or you'll lose a life. You'll receive a

free man at the 20,000 point plateau and again at 70,000 points.

Make a point at trying to grab the stolen items in pairs. This will increase your score generously if you can grab the treasure while it's flashing. The stolen items include a safe, a radio, a painting, and a computer. If you can find the safe that's flashing after grabbing the first one, it's worth 4X the points.

You can also slow down your pursuers by opening the glowing green door and unleashing the "microwave". This will sweep Meowsky (depending on the number) and GORO, away for a Mystery Score. Cats will also be stunned when you hit them with regular doors. There are 4 of these doors in all, so use them wisely. Striking cats with a bell (starting at Round 8) also produces a Mystery Score.

Finally, Rounds 3, 7, 11, and 15 are bonus rounds. If you gather all the balloons in the required time, you receive 5,000 points and an additional 5,000 after that.

BATTLE MODES JUGGERNAUT / MYSTIQUE / SABRETOOTH

Begin Battle Modes via the scoop at the start of each ball, or after completing the D-E-A-D target bank.

Battle modes are played like a side scroller/beat-em-up, with the objective to deplete enemy strength and then finish off the enemy at the scoop.

Deadpool will take damage at intervals if lit shots aren't being made. Running out of health or draining during the Battle will result in a loss.

NINJA MULTIBALL

Complete P-O-O-L target bank to light locks via inner-right lane-to-ramp shot.

Make right ramp to lock ball. Lock 3 balls to start Ninja Multiball.

During Ninja Multiball, shoot all major shots for Jackpots. This will qualify a Super Jackpot at the right ramp, which is the sum of every Jackpot collected.

TOURNAMENT STRATEGY

Battles stack well with Multiball features — Ex. Mystique Battle combined with Ninja Multiball can lead to big points, thanks to the right ramp scoring points during the Battle and also awarding Super Jackpots during Ninja Multiball. Try to combine with Playfield X Multipliers, which can range from 2X to 5X, by collecting target bank lights and hitting the Lil' Deadpool target.

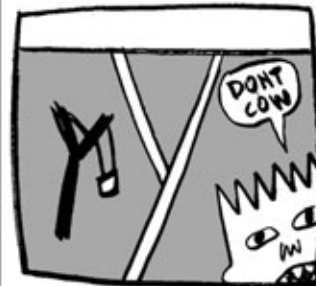

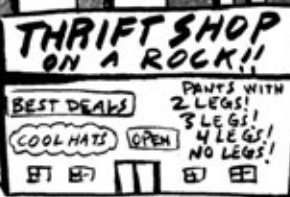

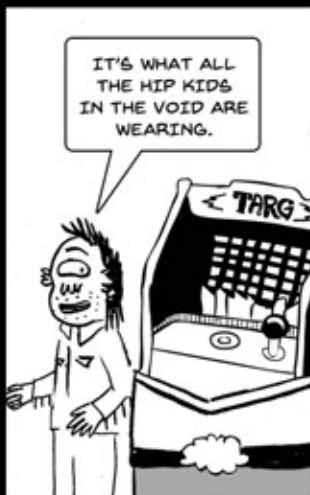

THE HUMAN TRIPODS

Lowertown Records, 1988

We are heading way back to 1988, with The Human Tripods self-titled LP. At the time, I was barely a teenager, plotting my eventual escape from the lovely, but sleepy, town of Peterborough to the land of excitement that is Canada's capital. I would find out the truth soon enough.

We're talking pre-internet, folks, so I'm flying blind here and may fudge some facts. Just go with it.

The band consisted of TIM DUNLOP (guitar, vox), DAVID BIGNELL (guitar, keys, vox), DOUG LILLICO (bass, vox) and KEITH LILLICO (drums, percussion, vox). Bignell is still active, having been a member of THE HAMMERHEADS and now playing with CLOUD OF ROCK (they're great, check them out). The Lillicos, who I'm assuming are brothers, played together previously in a ska/reggae band called the Pushkins, and the influence of that genre is prominent here.

Dunlop is more of a mystery. My sources from the 80s Ottawa scene tell me there were "about a million" Dunlop brothers all actively contributing to the arts, from playing in bands to hosting college radio shows to working in record shops. One interesting thing I found is a two man group called Singing Fools, active from 1982-90, with one of the members being a Tim Dunlop. Singing Fools released a single in 1982 called The Bum Rap, featuring samples of Pierre Trudeau and garnering substantial airplay, with some

claiming it was Canada's first "rap record". No idea if it's the same Tim Dunlop, but fun story!

This record has a ska/reggae feel, with lots of "skank" guitar (you know the style, that bouncy feel of upstrokes on the 2 and 4) and slower reggae type grooves, but also veers into rock and roll territory with some classic lead guitar licks and call and response vocal parts. The rhythm section is driving this bus (as you would expect for the style), and the guitar, keyboards and vocals fit seamlessly into the songs. I hear traces of B52s, early Devo, Talking Heads, and Chuck Berry in different spots. The band sounds young here (I think it's safe to assume they were), but they are already accomplished players.

One standout is a cover of the 1963 Eydie Gormé hit single "Blame it on the Bossa Nova". This is a great version, and shows the chops of the band while also letting the listener know that they aren't taking themselves too seriously. In fact, the lyrics are often less than serious, with titles like Sex Message from Outer Space, Subway Lizard, and We're Gonna Rock ('til we do something else).

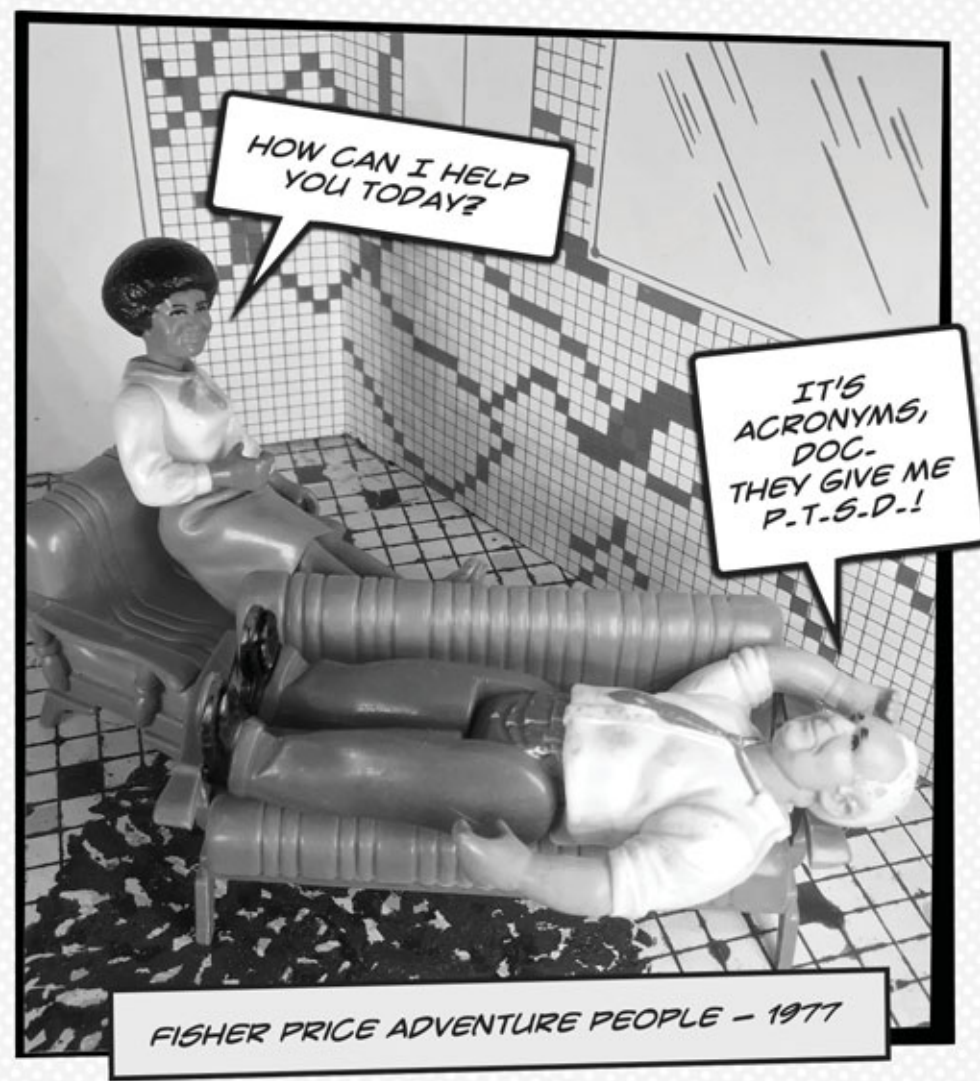

She is well-known as the station manager for CHUO FM, Ottawa's leading independent campus radio station. She even owns/runs a recording studio, writer's retreat and vegan kitchen in a beautiful renovated church in Quyon, QC!

I stumbled in to radio broadcasting at college somewhat randomly. From there I completed my co-op at CKCU and fell in love with independent radio. I got a job at CHUO as production coordinator in 1996 and have been working there (with a few breaks) ever since. I love music and love elevating people doing good work – which has led me to joining the steering committee for Ladyfest Ottawa (2005-2007), since then I have sat on the board of Apt613.ca and House of PainT. I am a POLARIS music prize juror and occasional writer for earSHOT. My most recent side hustle is as the regional coordinator

for ROACT (Regional Outaouais Arts And Culture Touring network). Oh, and I bought a Church in Quyon that is a recording studio and occasional venue.

As Station Manager at CHUO, no day is typical, but they are all fun. I spend most of my time working with staff and volunteers to make the best radio we can – whether that is strategizing with our Program Director, talking to volunteers about new ideas, writing grant applications or fostering partnerships with influencers and key community members. I also find time to do the core tasks of my day –

general administration, finances and HR.

I am proud to have successfully negotiated ownership of our antennae – saving the station tens of thousands of dollars and putting us in a position to improve our signal and maybe even generate new revenue by co-locating with another station. BUT I think my biggest accomplishment is being open to learning – this has allowed me to cultivate a strong staff team and collaborative environment.

Being part of something that has a real impact in my community. Seeing individuals overcome challenges, and do something they couldn't before they arrived. Working in a place that embodies values that truly empower individual community members.

I often look to my peers in other cities or around the world for best practices and new ideas. Lots of communication and collaboration means there is no end to potential projects.

HOW DO YOU KEEP UP WITH THE LATEST NEWS IN YOUR LINE OF WORK?

There are few key websites but a lot of it comes from meeting with my peers at other independent stations.

We are in an exciting time of radio – audio consumption is at an all time high. Technology has enabled content creation and distribution – civic journalism is on the rise. Working in independent media is more than a media job, it is about community connections.

NIGHTMARE CINEMA - WHEN THE LIGHTS GO DOWN, YOUR TIME IS UP!

There's a great history of horror genre anthology storytelling.

In the 1950's EC Comics published Vault of Horror, Haunt of Fear, and Tales from the Crypt. The campy chills within entertained readers, while causing media attention grabbing controversy from fretting grown-ups worried about the comics influence on kids.

From the mid 1950s, into the 1960s saw the rise of television showcasing popular serialized offerings in The Twilight Zone, The Outer Limits, and Alfred Hitchcock Presents.

The 1970s saw the comic book brand make it to the silver screen with Tales from the Crypt, and Vault of Horror.

From the late 1970s into the early 1980s, some of Stephen King's best work started showing up in collections like Night Shift, Skeleton Crew, and Different Seasons.

Likely the most well known modern horror anthology came from another re-branding of Tales from the Crypt, in the form an HBO series hosted by the pun wielding Crypt Keeper, that ran for seven seasons. After that, it spun off the less successful movies: Demon Knight, Bordello of Blood, and Ritual. Amongst plenty of merchandise, of interest to House of Targ fans, there was also a pinball machine.



The iconic modern movie monster Freddy Krueger dipped a claw into the genre with his tv series Freddy's Nightmares. And, there were even creepy Canadian Content kid friendly scares with Are You Afraid of the Dark, and Goosebumps.

Anthology holds a special place in many a movie geek heart, with titles like Trilogy of Terror, Creepshow, Cat's Eye, and Tales from the Darkside. The genre continues to draw viewers to our box office. We've screened a number of frightening anthologies, including Tales of Halloween, V/H/S, The ABC's of Death, XX, and A Christmas Horror Story.



Nightmare Cinema, this latest chapter in the legacy, is the brainchild of Mick Garris. His resume includes episodes of Steven Spielberg's Amazing Stories, and this film spins off stylistically from his tv anthology Masters of Horror.

This film has its multiple segments kicking off from the inciting incident of five down-on-their-luck strangers converging at an abandoned haunted cinema, run by a traditional comic book horror host, The Projectionist (played by Oscar nominee Mickey Rourke). The movies within the movie hit the screen, and the characters each witness their own nightmarish futures, as their deepest fears are told over a quintet of chapters.

Nightmare Cinema features a framing sequence and a short from producer Mick Garris (The Stand), plus segments from a diverse batch of acclaimed horror alum: Joe Dante (Gremlins), David Slade (30 Days of Night), Ryûhei Kitamura (Versus), and Alejandro Brugués (Juan of the Dead)!

I believe all movies are better served being seen in a cinema. But, if there's one genre that really deserves the big screen treatment, it's horror.

There's nothing like the roller coaster of scares and fun from seeing a horror movie in the darkened Mayfair, with no distractions, with an appreciative crowd. Don't miss the Ottawa Premiere of Nightmare Cinema the week of June 21st!

#2 How do you make a dull game more exciting? Take a hint from

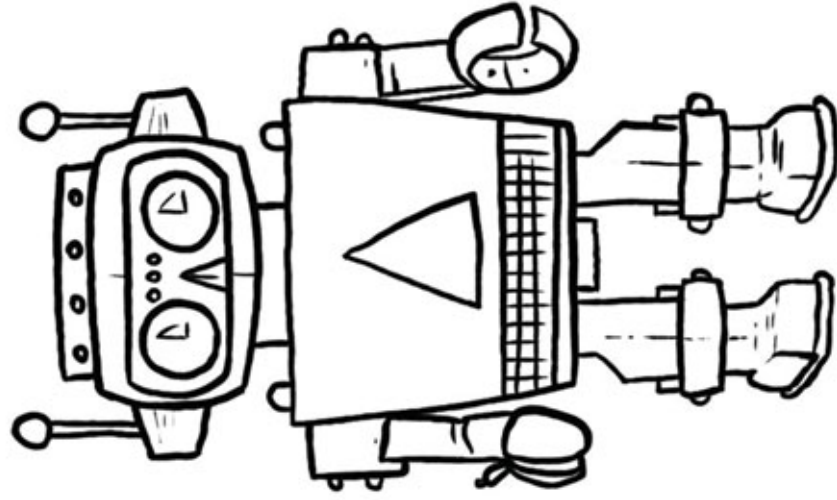
