

TOTAL CARAGE (Midway 1992) is an arcade top-down dual-joystick shooter and is often seen as a spiritual successor to Midway's earlier SmashTV. If you like full on over the top cartoon cathartic silliness this game will bring a smile to you face. I won't even bother trying to explain the cuckoo banana plot line but it takes place in 1999 and you will party like it is 1999 fighting off a monster that spits an unlimited supply of severed tongues at you... whaaat?!! The graphics are stylistically amazing and seeing yourself get a hole blown through your chest and launched into the air is worth the price of a credit alone. Best of all you can play cooperatively (as the 2 dudes on this months TARG Zine Cover no doubt) so you can share the surreal experience with a pal. Too fun & weird to not try at least once!









ARCADE RUMOUR

Word on the street is that SUPER MARIO BROS Pinball is coming to TARG this month. Ya that's right - the hit vid game did in fact have a pinball port! It was released in 1992 by Gottlieb & was the first machine by the manufacturer to use a DOT MATRIX display & has a sweet video mode that you will have to discover yourself when it arrives. Fun fact - Despite the name "Super Mario Bros.", the machine appears to share a majority of its artwork with Super Mario World, released two years before.

Is there no end to Atari 's video game madness? From CENTIPEDE (1980) to SUPER SPRINT (1986), and CHAMPIONSHIP SPRINT (1987), the creative and glorious mind of Atari speaks for itself. With that in mind, we bring you ROADBLASTERS, Atari's latest creation to the video game driving world.

Set in a post-apocalyptic future timeline (the year isn't mentioned), the player is equipped with a Lamborghini-like sports car with only one gear-speed. With the combination of SUPER SPRINT and S.T.U.N RUNNER, players drive through a barren highway destroying other cars, motorbikes, as well as avoid mines, all while collecting fuel pods (the red and green ones) to

add and sustain your fuel supply. On some levels you will start off with only half a tank of fuel, which means getting as many fuel pods as you can is mandatory. The game ends when both your regular and auxiliary fuel supplies are exhausted.

The speech, sound effects and music are futuristic and captivating. The game will also allow you to start from and at certain levels of the "race" (Level I, or 4, or Ia). There are 50 levels in all. While your firepower on your car is adequate, a plane will swoop in and drop a special weapon to enhance your performance. These enhanced items include a UZ cannon, a cruise missile, an electro shield, and a nitro injector. Use all these weapons wisely as you won't have them for too long.

WATCH OUT FOR THE ROADSIDE CANNONS! These side-of-the-road nemesis are found along the curves and will destroy your car unexpectedly. Once you finish a level by crossing a spacious checker line, the remaining fuel bonus is added to your score. See you next month gamers!

SOME MIGHT REMEMBER HIS AWESOME METAL REVIEWS IN THE OTTAWA CITIZEN, WHILE OTHERS WOULD KNOW HIM AS AN AVID HOT WHEELS COLLECTOR. SHAWN "JAM" HILL, (A NICK NAME GIVEN TO HIM BY BRYAN CURRY OF ANDREW VINCENT & THE PIRATES) ALSO MANAGED

TO MAKE A HUGE IMPACT ON THE LOCAL UNDERGROUND MUSIC SCENE BY ADDING HIS SPECIAL "SKREEDLE" SPICE GUITAR SKILLS TO SEVERAL BANDS FROM 1991 TO 2013 BEFORE **EVENTUALLY TAKING A BREAK FROM MUSIC TO PURSUE CAREER** & FAMILY, HERE ARE SOME OF SHAWN'S BANDS THAT ENRICHED THE OTTAWA MUSIC SCENE...

MUSHROOM EXPLOSION

Mushroom Explosion began during his High School days at Earl of March in 1991. The band also included Rob



Snasdell-Taylor, Scott Terry, and James Bryant. When the band first started, Shawn didn't even know how to play a powerchord. In 1993, They recorded the album Who Cares? with Heavendog's Oliver Marsh.

JENNIFER BLAND/ROUGH JUSTICE

At Trent University, in Peterborough, Shawn was part of a couple of bands: The experimental jam band called Jennifer Bland; and Rough Justice, a band that combined live music with recorded music. Members included Richard Williams (drums), Drew Van Allen (bass) and Alan (quitar). They were around for several shows over more than a year circa 1996/1997. No recordings of these groups were made.

THE WAXIES/KING KUNG

When returning to Ottawa during this time Shawn would reunite with Rob Snasdell-Taylor, in the Waxies, with Callum Browne (drums) and former Triphammer bassist Johnny Nash. They released the cassette

American Tailpipe in 1997. Callum left to become a DJ, and Shawn left to head out west. Rob would later form King Kung, with Johnny and Scott Terry. Shawn joined in whenever he returned to Ottawa from his travels. They released the 7" Oregon & the Enemies of Rock and the CD Smashing Glass/ Breaking Hearts (1999).

ROCKTAGON

Rocktagon was a shortlived group that

Shawn was a part of around this time with Scott Terry, Dave Jackson and Mike Caffrey. They played a handful of shows. No recordings of this group were made.

THE BITCHIN' CAMAROS

When King Kung decided to call it a day, Jean Belanger, from Keener, quickly scooped up Shawn for a new project

called the Bitchin' Camaros, which released a selftitled CD in 2002. This band toured the country twice. Belanger left for Montreal to join Bionic, leaving a second Bitchin' Camaros album slated to be titled

THE BANDITAS

In 2001, Shawn was part of The Banditas with Liz McDermott, with other members, at times, including Scott Terry, Kosta McKay, Jim Sproull and John Sproull. The band recorded a couple of demos.

before Liz decided to strip the band to a two-piece in 2003 with Scott, to perform at Ladyfest, which had a 50% women requirement for bands.

I gotta say, it was a happy day for me when this little gem of an album was finally released on vinyl, and in glorious mono no less! Great for ensuring a quality listen on a dusty old system or even through suspect earbuds.

From the opening double hits of this record, you're going to want to sing along. This is some seriously catchy, three-piece rock and roll, played by some of Ottawa's most accomplished players. ANDREW VINCENT is a great songwriter, and he knows his way around a guitar. The Pirates, BRYAN CURRY and SCOTT TERRY, form a solid bedrock that keeps these songs propelling along nicely. Throw in appearances from DAVE DRAVES, JARRETT BARTLETT, and MIKE SHULTZ and you have an all-star ensemble.

These songs revolve around Vincent's jangly, bright, cleanish guitar tone, with clever lyrics that Ottawans will relate to, great lead singing and impressive harmonies from the band



throughout. The combination of stripped-down arrangements using guitar, bass and drums and the catchy, three minute pop song formula immediately makes you want to dance. There isn't a stinker on this disc, just ten well-crafted toe-tappers that will have you listening over and over again. This one is in high rotation here at MEOW! THAT'S HOT KITCHEN + BAR, and is Steph's (co-owner) favourite record to get everyone in a party mood.

AN INTERVIEW WITH

MELINDA MASSOLAS

JOB TITLE: SOUND TECH AT BLACK SQUIRREL BOOKS AGE: 24 | BORN: SAINT MARTIN ISLAND

Melinda is a multi-talented musician (vocals, guitar, drums) and an up and coming live sound tech at Black Squirrel Books. Originally from Calgary, she moved to Ottawa in 2017 and has been hard at work, honing her live sound skills since then. She started from the ground up by shadowing local techs & working in small venues and cafes around town. Welcome to Ottawa Melinda! We commend your hard work in our scene..

WHAT JOBS AND EXPERIENCES HAVE LED TO YOUR PRESENT POSITION(S)?

I used to be in band in Calgary and when I moved to Ottawa I wanted to still be a part of the music world sans band so I went to a sound workshop that targeted non-men to get them interested in sound. Lucky for me I knew Anthony Cardozo, the booker at Black Squirrel Books, and he let me practice and get better at mixing there. Worked out pretty well.

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL WORK DAY ENTAIL FOR YOU?

Arrive at the venue, set up, talk to folks or more likely wall flower (depends on my mood), try to find my earplugs, realise I forgot them yet again, Mix my ass off lol, take it all down, go home.

TELL US ABOUT A PROJECT OR

ACCOMPLISHMENT THAT YOU CONSIDER TO BE SIGNIFICANT IN YOUR CAREER.

This makes me think of the lil Uzi meme where someone ask's him how he likes wherever-place and he's like "I dunno man it's only my 3rd day out here" Hahaha I have not done too much to say. I'm still in my learning stages where successfully getting rid of some small feedback has me bragging to my friends sooo lol maybe that

WHAT DO YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT WORKING IN YOUR INDUSTRY?

I like that it is in music, it's a good way to discover new bands I might like. There's been many a time where I show up to mix and I've been pleasantly surprised by the band.

HOW DO YOU BEST SEEK OUT OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEW PROJECTS?

There's a lot of opportunity for networking at events. Ottawa isn't a huge place. Most people work on more than one event so just getting to know those around you, asking questions, figuring out where you might fit in and knowing what you like to do and are capable of doing is huge.

HOW DO YOU BEST SEEK OUT OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEW PROJECTS?

Talk to people, networking is key. Let them know who you are what you do, and be a pal. Maybe one day they'll need someone and think of you

HOW DO YOU KEEP UP WITH THE LATEST NEWS IN YOUR LINE OF WORK?

I don't really. I'm not a "keep up with stuff" kind of person. If I hear about something cool, word, but otherwise I am oblivious to the going ons of the sound world lol.

WHAT WOULD YOU TELL SOMEONE ABOUT TO START A CAREER IN YOUR FIELD?

Go for it! It's pretty rewarding in my opinion... Talk to your local sound person. Ask them if you can shadow them. Most people are stoked to show you






