GAME: RYGAR

When the Imperial Arcade on Bank & Gilmour existed 30 years ago, I saw at least 6 RYGAR

machines scattered around the premises. It might be a safe bet to say that the owners of the Imperial had a lot of time on their hands.

Created by TECHNO, RYGAR is celebrating Birthday No. 33. The actual full name is Rygar, Legendary Warrior. The graphics here are well drawn, with a little violence thrown in. The garner controls a barbarian warrior bent on taking down a dominator and its legions. The barbarian wields an interesting weapon... a razor sharped shockrum on a stretchable string that will cut his enemies to ribbons. The player has to be careful because the baddies are everywhere. They can be underground, above ground and in the air. You can use the shockrum in a spin-O-rama move to nullify the aerial attack. Rygar can even jump on his enemies, stunning them in the process and making them

through 27 levels of shattering horror... that's right, 27... some picture insignias will appear out of nowhere. Pick them up and they will appear in one office squares at the bottom of the screen.

As you make your way

easier to take out.

Each of these insignias will enhance you and your shockrum's abilities. The star extends the string on your weapon, whereas the castle gives the shockrum sharper blades, and there's one of a tiger that destroys the baddies as soon as you touch them. I haven't seen the other pictures yet.

Finally, when you finish a level, the amount of legions killed, warrior ranking, and time remaining will be added to your score. You get a free man at 200,000 points.

The designer of the game was John Borg, co-designer of the original Data East JP, whose resume features some heavy hitters including Tales From The Crypt, Iron Man, TRON, Metallica, The Walking Dead, and many more.

In this month's lesson I'll be going over the game's main multiball mode. Armed with this knowledge, maybe YOU could reach the winner's podium at the next House of TARG Monthly Pinball Tournament?!

MULTIBALL MODE

- Multiball is first started by repeatedly hitting the drop target to light all three locks.
- If you don't finish the drop target shots, one lock will be spotted for you each ball until you complete the drop target sequence or light all three locks.
- Lock three balls by hitting the lit LOCK shots at the left loop, right loop, and middle loop which then starts a 4-ball multiball.
- Ramps are lit for Jackpots which unlight when collected.
- When both ramps are collected, both loops light for Jackpots which unlight when collected.
- When both loop Jackpots have been collected, the middle loop lights for Super Jackpot.
- · Once the Super is collected, multiball starts back at stage one with the lit ramps.

SMART MISSLE

- Collect the Smart Missle awarded from the Egg scoop.
- Smart Missile only pertains to multiball activate it using the LAUNCH button.
- If the locks aren't lit, Smart Missile will light all locks (1st Multiball).
- If all locks are lit, Smart Missile will start multiball.
- During multiball, Smart Missile will collect any lit Jackpots.



BECOME THE DINOSAUR

To rack up some skill shot points you will need to use your reptilian brain: focus on the video display and time your ball launch so that the giant T-REX foot is directly over a HUMAN... then push the ball launch button to squash that mother. No points are awarded if you harm a fellow prehistoric beast.



MONOBROW THE NACARAT

Trill or be Thrilled records Recorded/mixed by Mike Bond at Wolf Lake Studios. Produced by Mike Bond and Monobrow

(Hey! This is my thirteenth column for the TARG zine, hard to believe it's been over a year since I started this super fun side gig! Big thanks to all the wizards for building this great community around music, games, art, and food, and for being all-around amazing people.)

Monobrow are an instrumental trio from Ottawa formed in 2009. The Nacarat is their fourth full length release, released in Spring 2017. The guys in the band are Brian Ahopelto on drums, Sam Bedyoun on bass, and Paul Slater on guitar, and this album features some guest synthesizer work by Shane Whitbread.

These guys are tough to pin down, as instrumental outfits can sometimes be. Enjoy some 60s/70s psych? You got it. More into doom or stoner rock? No problem, it's here. Fancy some heavy unison metal riffage? Coming right up. Need a dose of progressive rock? Well, here's some now. The songs can be on the longer side, but they shift and change enough to keep your attention. They are complex but approachable, with solid playing and surprisingly melodic lead guitar lines (never thought I'd say anything nice about this effect, but I enjoy



Slater's restrained use of the wah-wah pedal here). In one composition, you can find yourself drifting away on a gentle trance progression, then jolted back to reality with a left turn into headbanging heaviness.

This is a five song concept album, with and undercurrent of societal upheaval as hinted in song titles such as "The First Vague Rumblings Of Impending Revolution", "We Can Make It Look Like An Accident" and "The Decline Of The West And Other Small Tragedies". In addition, there are "words" included for the songs in the liner notes, written by Ryan Kjrr, who you may know from bands like Uncooperatives and Phantom Shifters. These words aren't sung, but are asset of companion poems to the musical journey, and help add to the feel or concept of the album as a whole.

In all, this was an ambitious project for the band and they executed it well. It sounds great on vinyl (my copy is a sweet orange/cream swirl pressing) and should still be fairly easy to find around town. In fact, if you happen to come across any of Monobrow's albums, they are definitely worth picking up. The band is still active, and plays live fairly frequently so keep your eyes and ears open!



AN INTERVIEW WITH

JENN JEFFERYS

OCCUPATION: INDEPENDENT WRITER AND JOURNALIST SPECIALIZING IN POP CULTURE, OTTAWA LIVE MUSIC, CANADIAN POLITICS AND CURRENT EVENTS

Jenn is an artist, writer, communications professional, and proud feminist. She is a regular contributor to Apt613 and Ottawa Showbox, and is regularly sought after for public affairs commentary by radio and podcast. Keep making waves by doing what you love and speaking your voice Jenn!

WHAT JOBS AND EXPERIENCES HAVE LED TO YOUR PRESENT POSITION(S)?

I'm a bit of a Jane of all trades (and master of none). I've worked everywhere. I had a brief stint working coat check at Barrymore's. Slinging empties and tall cans at Somerset Beer Store. Helping kids with permanent physical (dis)abilities learn how to kayak and swim at an Easter Seals Camp. Bartending. Babysitting. Stand up comedy. Live-tweeting. Briefing politicians before they go on TV. And a lot of freelance writing and communications stuff.

WHAT DOES A TYPICAL WORK DAY ENTAIL FOR YOU?

Reluctantly wake up and stumble over to my radio to turn on CBC Ottawa Morning (I hate mornings). Make a green tea and examine the dishes and laundry I probably neglected to do the night before. Bus or catch a Lyft to my office in Centretown. Do communications and writing stuff for the man with some very cool people in an office for 7.5 hours. Walk home.

Admire this stunningly beautiful city we live in and probably chat with a few tourists and strangers (I like offering to take pictures for people because I'm weird). And I take a lot of photographs. And sometimes watch the sunset near the locks beside Parliament.

TELL US ABOUT A PROJECT OR ACCOMPLISHMENT THAT YOU CONSIDER TO BE SIGNIFICANT IN YOUR CAREER.

Probably the coolest thing I ever had the privilege of doing at work happened when I was on the comms team at the Assembly of First Nations. I pitched a segment concept to the producers for This Hour Has 22 Minutes (on CBC television) then briefed both National Chief Bellegarde and comedian/host Mark Critch before a really funny and smart nationally-televised interview on the show. I'm a bit of a control freak, but working with my team at the AFN and the amazing cast and crew of 22 Minutes to make that segment happen was really awesome.

WHAT DO YOU LIKE MOST ABOUT WORKING IN YOUR INDUSTRY?

When I can go home at the end of a really long week and know that I made a difference. Even just a tiny one.

HOW DO YOU BEST SEEK OUT OPPORTUNITIES FOR NEW PROJECTS?

I'm pretty annoying and persistent. It's rare that I would give up on someone or something. When I want something, I go for it. F*ck that inner voice telling me I'm not good enough.






